Dog Licenses expire March 31st of each year. Massachusetts State Law requires all dogs 6 months of age and older be licensed in their respective town or city, and have proof of a current rabies vaccination on file.

All previously licensed dogs who are licensed AFTER July 1st will be charged an additional \$25.00.

PLEASE NOTE: 5 or more dogs requires a Kennel License and all Kennels must be inspected by the Animal Control Officer. When registering as a Kennel: 5-9 dogs, \$40.00; 10 or more dogs, \$50.00.
